Volunteer Opportunity

Hebron Interfaith Human Services (HIHS) is working with Foodshare, the Marlborough food bank, and the Andover Department of Social Services to begin hosting the mobile Foodshare van to better serve area residents.

This program provides fresh produce and other food items.

HIHS is seeking volunteers from Hebron, Andover, and Marlborough to assist with: food distribution, traffic/parking control, and assisting clients where necessary.

The Foodshare bus will be located at the First Congregational Church at the junctions of Rtes 85 & 66. Volunteers should expect to be present at the site for approximately 2 hours, every other week beginning August 17th at approximately 11:00. The bus runs all year.
